VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

Sous chef (assistant cook) at Ambassador's residence

1. Requirements:

(1.1) right to reside in the United Kingdom, and legal entitlement to take full-time paid employment;

(1.2) identity document and written references;

(1.3) aged at least 18;

(1.4) fluency in English, and knowledge of Portuguese or Spanish;

(1.5) (for Brazilian nationals) compliance with duties of military service and voting;

(1.6) (for Brazilian nationals) a written statement declaring that the applicant does not hold another post, and is not in public service;

(1.7) in addition to presenting documents demonstrating compliance with the above requirements, applicants should also submit a CV, one passport-size photograph, and completed application form;

(1.8) the monthly remuneration will be £1,700.00 (one thousand, seven hundred pounds);

(1.9) As well as kitchen duties – including substituting for the head cook when he/she is absent – the responsibilities of the sous chef (assistant cook) at Ambassador's residence is to comprise general domestic tasks such as table service, cleaning, answering the phone, door keeping, etc.

The sous chef (assistant cook) at Ambassador's residence working hours will be in accordance with the British legislation for domestic servants in private houses and will be required to be continuously available during certain periods, in accordance with a pre-arranged timetable. In addition, he or she may be called to work at short notice should an urgent need arise.

The successful applicant will have to go through a three months paid probation period.

(2.0) Applications must be submitted *in person* at the Embassy between the 5th and the 19th November (Mon-Fri only), 9:30am-12.30pm or 2.30-17.30pm.
